Non-participation in the market sounding exercise shall not prevent any supplier from participating in the procurement process. Highways England will be sharing dialogue points with the market for discussion during the engagement process (workshops, written feedback / thoughts or information sessions) via email in advance to all registered interested suppliers. Note that for practical and logistical reasons not every organisation who registers interest will be able to participate in the market sounding workshops, which will be jointly co-ordinated with the support of key industry bodies, including (but not limited to) The Institute of Civil Engineers and the Civil Engineering Contractors Association. Please also note that all information shared in the workshops and via the written feedback will be shared to the market in an outcomes report and information session in March 2018. Highways England has ambitious objectives to modernise, maintain and operate the Strategic Road Network. Our work supports economic growth by connecting people and businesses across England, while making the network safer for those using and working on them. The aim of the new procurement model is to enable us to achieve this through securing a sustainable supply chain by developing close, more collaborative and longer-lasting relationships with suppliers – helping to deliver “whole-life” value to our contracts.</p>
