#### Competition Guidelines:

- Entries must feature or have a link to civil engineering projects in Scotland (preferably recent projects).
- Images must be submitted in jpeg format with a minimum resolution of 3 Megapixels.
- Whilst entries using camera phones are expected, entries taken using more traditional camera equipment will still be accepted and should be submitted to the same competition email address using the process described above.
- Should entries be received without identifying #hashtags, they shall be submitted under a suitable category at the discretion of the Photo Competition team.
- Prize for the top image in each category will be £150 of photography equipment vouchers.
- A separate committee award will also be presented. The winner of this award will be invited as a guest of the committee to the GWoS Annual Branch Dinner.
