**Annual Photographic Competition 2016**  
**Competition Terms and Conditions**

1. The purpose of the competition is to foster an interest in the photography of civil engineering projects in Scotland and enhance the image library of ICE Scotland which is used in the promotion of civil engineering.
2. The competition will commence on Monday 8 February 2016 and the final date for receipt of entries is 17.00hrs on Friday 16 September 2016.
3. Entry is open to any current member (of any grade) who is enrolled in the ICE Scotland Region. Any Group or Organisation who have elected to collaborate on a submission must designate one person as agent; the submission will be dealt with as if there was a single entrant and these terms and conditions are applicable to all of the Group or Organisation.
4. Images must be of or related to Civil Engineering subjects located in Scotland. Each entrant may submit images of any number of projects or subjects but each project or subject is limited to three images. Images may be colour or black and white.
5. Images shall be original work and shall not have been previously published or exploited in any part nor should infringe the copyright, right of privacy or any other right of any third party. Images must be suitable for display and publication and should not in any respect interfere with the good standing of ICE.
6. Entries should be submitted via the competition email address:

7. Images must be in .jpg digital format and be of printing quality (2000 x 1500 pixels or higher).
8. Defined #hashtags shall be used above to identify the entry category for each image. These are: #construction; #engineering; #selfie. No other #hashtag categories shall be accepted.
9. Should entries be received without identifying #hashtags, they shall be submitted under a suitable category at the discretion of the Photo Competition team.
10. Information regarding the subject, title and location of entries may be requested by the organisers for image library purposes. Failure to provide this information if requested will result in the image being withdrawn from the competition.
11. Judging shall be carried out by an on-line voting process open to ICE members. In the event of a tied vote, the Chair of the Glasgow and West of Scotland Publications & Communications sub-committee shall have the deciding vote. The Judges reserve the right not to award some or all of the prizes.
12. Entry in more than one category will be allowed, but an individual photo cannot win more than one category. Should this occur, the Photo Competition team shall award the prize to the second place photo of their choosing.
13. Prizes for the winning image in each category (if selected) will be: Photographic equipment vouchers to the value of £100. Winners will be notified as soon as possible after the closing

date and prizes will be presented at the first appropriate Branch Technical Meeting following the judging.

14. Each member of the Glasgow and West of Scotland committee shall be asked to vote for their favourite image out of the category winners, with each member having one vote. The winner of this vote shall be invited to the Annual Branch Dinner as a guest of the committee. In the event of a tied vote, the Chair of the Glasgow and West of Scotland Publications & Communications sub-committee shall have the deciding vote.
15. By submitting an entry to the Competition, Entrants grant ICE Scotland a nonexclusive, royalty-free, worldwide licence to republish images in print and electronic format for purposes connected with the ICE and promotion of Civil Engineering (without acknowledgement) and the right to use entrants name and town or city of residence for the sole purpose of identifying the entrant as the author of the entry. Each prize winner consents to the Promoter publishing their name and home town in any media in connection with this Competition.
16. Entrants shall ensure that they have received the consent of all persons prominently featured in any image to the entry being used and published under these terms and conditions and are able to produce written copies of such permissions if required. If any person under the age of 18 features, parental consent must be given in writing and contact details given to enable confirmation.
17. By entering the Competition, all entrants will be deemed to have accepted and be bound by the terms and conditions. These terms and conditions shall be governed by the law of Scotland and the courts of Scotland shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
