This 5-day programme explores South Korea's renewable energy systems, transport infrastructure, academic collaboration, and integrated stadium to inspire sustainable and future-ready urban development.

The delegation will engage in:

Renewable & clean energy exploration

Visits to major energy facilities—including tidal power, hydroelectric systems—highlight South Korea's commitment to sustainable power generation and carbon neutral development.

Transport, tunnelling & mobility infrastructure

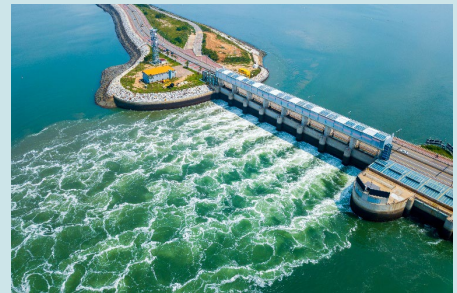
Explore metropolitan motorway design, and tunnel construction in South Korea—highlight engineering solutions that support infrastructure development in dense and rapidly growing urban areas.

Academic & professional exchange

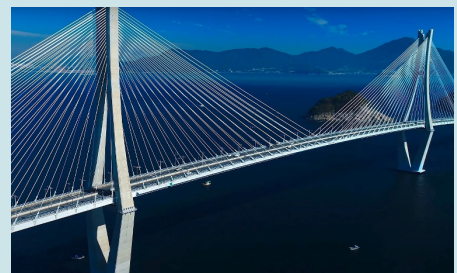
A university visit fosters dialogue with Korean civil engineering professionals, students and researchers, strengthening cross boundary collaboration and knowledge sharing.

Paldang Dam — a major hydroelectric and water resources facility supporting the Seoul metropolitan region.
