



# G&S: mock CPR workshop 2026

## About mock CPR workshop 2026

ICE HKA G&S will organise a **full-length** mock Chartered Professional Review (CPR) workshop designed to replicate the actual CPR experience. Experienced facilitators will evaluate candidates' performance and provide constructive feedback to participants. To ensure quality delivery, each session is limited to 34, including two candidates and 32 observers. The workshop will cover the entire review process, enabling participants to develop a thorough understanding of the practical skills required for the CPR.

Candidates are required to submit their Professional Review reports, including a two-page CV and appendices. To **fully align** with the current CPR arrangements, the presentation will last for 15 minutes, followed by maximum of 60 minutes interview with the facilitators. Feedback for the candidate will then be provided by the facilitators.

Observers will spectate the presentation and interview. They are also welcome to raise questions in the Q&A session.

Applicants who are applying for candidate roles but attended any mock CPR workshops in the immediately previous session (late 2025) as candidates will be given lower priority than other applicants. Successful applicants will receive a notification email on how to proceed with payment. Shortlisted candidates will be separately informed to submit their Professional Review reports, which shall include a two-page CV and appendices, by a specified deadline, failing which their applications may lapse.
