STEM Ambassador of the Year 2025 – Minimum entry requirements

Entries are open for all individuals who:

1. Are a current ICE member living or working in Wales.
2. Are registered as a STEM Learning Ambassador.
3. Involved in STEM activity in the last year as an ICE STEM Ambassador, including digital events.

Nominations can be made by the individuals themselves or by another ICE member on behalf of an individual they would like to see recognised. (The individual in question will need to complete the form answering all the relevant questions).

Nominations are requested on the separate form provided.

The judges will be looking for detailed description of your STEM activity - remembering that the ICE priority is the 16-18 age group although all activity should be described.

You will need to give details on when and how you engaged with young people and tell us why you chose the particular activities, how you prepared and delivered the exercise, and how you measured the success of the engagement. Please summarise all your STEM activity condensed into 700 words, you can attach photographs and supplementary evidence.

Please note also that the letter of support from your employer should be as detailed as possible, also telling us why they think you should be considered for this Award of excellence.

Applicants should send their entry forms to wales.cymru@ice.org.uk by **midnight Monday 7 April 2025**. Entries received after this date will not be considered.
